...then as quickly as it started it stopped so the submarine started to head back.

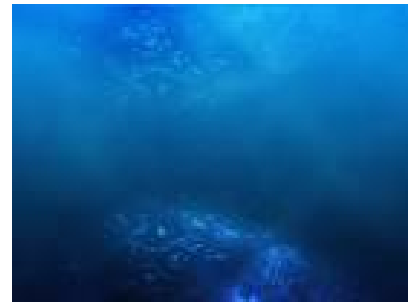
A shadow went over us and then we eventually reached Sea King. As we entered the harbour, I said to John the captain “We’ll head back in an hour, ok”
